Archetype and Tarot Mini-Ritual

The Mother and Three of Pentacles

With the wisdom of The Mother and Three of Pentacles this week being all about collaboration, we're going to do a ritual to learn to help us find where we most need collaboration at this time.

What you will need:

- A Three of Pentacles tarot card from the Arthur Waite/Coleman-Smith deck.
- An object to represent the worker in the card (perhaps a hammer or other tool).
- An object to represent the resource provider in the card (perhaps a coins).
- An object to represent the planner in the card (perhaps a pen or small notebook).

Process:

- Open your sacred space however you like.
- Invite in your primary helper spirits and ask them to resource you with clearing and protection.
- Now focus on your energetic boundary. Try to really feel this sphere of protection that encircles you. Notice if there are any weak spots and ask your spirit helpers to strengthen this for you.
- Place the tarot card and all three objects on your altar, or in front of you in your sacred space.
- Look at the card. Spend a moment studying each of the three people on the card, noting the way your own energy feels as you connect with each one.
- Now say aloud to your spirit helpers: "Please guide me to the collaborator I most need at this time; when I touch their tool, give me a strong sign."
- Place your hand on the object that represents the worker. Notice how you feel. Notice any sensations in your hand especially. Listen for any sounds in the room or any flashes of image in your mind. Stay with it until you feel complete.
- Repeat the above for the other two objects.
- Notice which of the three came with the strongest impressions. This is the one who can help you the most right now. Is it the worker, the financier/resource provider, or the planner? Have you been fulfilling all three roles on your own?
- Think of who you know in your life that can collaborate with you in this role.
- When you feel complete, offer gratitude and close your space.
