Archetype and Tarot Mini-Ritual

The Gem and The Empress

With the wisdom of The Gem and The Empress this week being all about excavating our inner treasure, we're going to do a practice to reconnect with this part of ourselves.

First, create a sacred space where you can connect with the energies around and within you. This can be anywhere you feel most at peace—your garden, a quiet room, or even a secluded spot in a park. Light some candles to invite warmth and clarity into your space, and if you like, burn some sage or incense to cleanse the air and ward off any negative vibes. This step is all about setting the stage for introspection and spiritual exploration.

Next, gather symbols of the elements—earth, air, fire, water—to honor the connectedness of all things and to ground your ritual in the physical world. A bowl of soil or a plant for earth, a feather or incense for air, a candle for fire, and a bowl of water will do. Place these around you, forming a circle of protection and power. As you arrange these elements, focus on your intention to discover the treasure within.

Now, sit comfortably within your circle, close your eyes, and take deep, grounding breaths. Visualize yourself standing at the entrance to a hidden cave—this is the gateway to your inner self. As you enter, imagine yourself walking down a path lined with glowing crystals, each one representing a part of your inner treasure. With each step, feel yourself getting closer to your core, to the essence of who you are. When you reach the heart of the cave, see a chest aglow with golden light. Open it and discover what lies inside. These are the gifts you carry within you—perhaps qualities you've forgotten or never knew you had. Take a moment to embrace these treasures, thanking them for revealing themselves to you.

To close the ritual, slowly bring your awareness back to the present, carrying the feeling of your inner treasure with you. Blow out the candles, thanking the elements for their guidance and protection. Remember, the treasures you've discovered are not meant to be hidden away. They're gifts to be nurtured, developed, and shared with the world. Each time you perform this ritual, you may find new treasures or deepen your relationship with those you've already discovered. The magic of this practice is that it evolves with you, always offering new depths to explore and new strengths to uncover.
